Regular Meeting Minutes

Platte County

**Present:** Mayor Susan Juschka, Council Members: Jeston Cundall, Heather Schoning, and Kelly Jones. Clerk/Treasurer Kelsey Crabtree, Assistant Clerk Heather Good, Public Works Director Steve Eller.

6PM Mayor Juschka calls the meeting to order, asks all to stand and recite the Pledge of Allegiance.

### **Approvals**

**Agenda** – Heather Schoning motions to approve. Kelly Jones seconds the motion. All in favor, motion is carried.

**May 14, 2025, Regular Meeting Minutes:** Heather Schoning would like to amend a spelling error under Jeston Cundall’s commissioner reports, also two motions were made under the Trading Post 24-Hr malt beverage permits, where only one was listed. Kelly Jones motions to approve with the above amendments. Jeston Cundall seconds the motion. All in favor, motion is carried.

**May 20, 2025, Special Meeting Minutes:** Heather Schoning motions to approve. Kelly Jones seconds the motion. All in favor, motion carried.

**May 2025 Treasurers report:** Kelly Jones motions to approve. Jeston Cundall seconds the motion. All in favor, motion is carried.

**June 2025 Claims for consideration:** Platte County Chamber of Commerce membership discussion. We will extend an invitation to the director to attend next month’s meeting. Discussion on having a fire department storage shed purchased and placed on the town lot. This will be discussed with the Fire Department. Heather Schoning motions to approve June 2025 claims. Jeston Cundall seconds the motion. All in favor, motion is carried.

### **Commissioner Reports:**

**Streets & Alleys-** Jeston Cundall noticed different leaks on Lincoln Street that Steve Eller is already addressing.

**Water & Sewer-** Heather Schoning and Steve Eller are still talking with Coffey about our meter situation. Looking for a time frame on Haygood’s water meter and fixing the curb stop out on Lazy Pants. Discussion on overgrown properties around town, and whether we should send letters to the property owners. Steve and Heather have been looking into a new mower that Jeston and Steve will go and look at as a possible purchase for the town.

**Airport/Park/Cemetery-** Kelly Jones has spoken with Dallas Mount who was on the Airport Board in Wheatland and got some information regarding different revenue streams and ideas regarding the airport. More discussion on our growing airport and some changes we should consider making.

**Mayor Juschka-** Thanks everyone who helped with and attended Glendo Dayz.

**New Business:**

**Travis John Building Permit-** This will be tabled to allow the town attorney to view the plans.

**Robynn Hill- Fireworks:** Glendo Events and Tourism Committee is going to put on the fireworks this year. Discussion on funding, Robynn asks the town to donate. Heather Schoning motions to donate \$1,000.00 to Glendo Events and Tourism Committee for fireworks. Kelly Jones seconds the motion. All in favor, motion is carried.

**Old Business:**

**Community Center-** Heather Schoning is still waiting for the bid for demolition from Eric Jones.

**Old Hotel-** The owner had an engineer come and look. Heather Schoning is curious about the camper behind the old hotel and what they are doing for water and sewer. Steve Eller says the curb stop is locked up, it cannot get turned on.

**Visionary Issues-** Discussion on updates and current complaints. Heather Schoning would like to have the town attorney take over.

**Liquor License Ordinance Second Reading-** Mayor Juschka adds that the town does not generally allow Malt Beverage Permits on town properties, such as the one for Doc and Robynn Hill.

Heather Schoning motions to approve Ordinance #180, Liquor License's second reading with the amendment of Catering permits and Temporary dispensing room should be changed from \$10.00 to \$50.00. Kelly Jones seconds the motion. All in favor, motion carried.

**25/26 Budget Third Reading-** Heather Schoning motions to approve the third and final reading of the 25/26 budget. Jeston Cundall seconds the motion. All in favor, motion is carried.

**Executive Session:**

At 6:54PM Kelly Jones motions to go into the executive session, to discuss matters of personnel. Heather Schoning seconds the motion. All in favor, motion is carried.

At 7:25PM Kelly Jones motions to end the executive session and the meeting to be moved back to regular session. Heather Schoning seconds the motion. All in favor, motion carried.

Heather Schoning motions to approve one employee and one town vehicle to deliver senior meals within 5 miles of town limits. Kelly Jones seconds the motion. All in favor, motion carried.
