Commissioner Reports

Streets & Alleys: Jeston Cundall reports roads are in same conditions, some need patched on Warren St.

Water & Sewer: Heather Schoning states we met with Kathy Weinsaft from Rural Water for potential grants for meters and the Downey well house. We will apply for a grant to help with this which will be due in December.

Park/Cemetery/Airport: Kelly Jones was not present. Mayor Juschka reads report from Greg Burke on behalf of Keep Glendo Great. They received a \$15,000 grant for a new fire tender. Update on the work on the welcome sign.

Clerk's Report: Kelsey Crabtree gives update on WAMCAT training she attended, states Missy Sonesen passed part of her Wyoming Pesticide Applicator Core test, still has an extension to take. Also, she found a new insurance company that will save the town right around \$18,000 this year.

Fire Dept: Chief Dave Noyce states there are four new volunteer fire fighters. They had their annual chili cook off last weekend, not as good of a turn out as prior years. They want to sale Engine 32, asking for proper protocol. On the first Wednesday of every month they have a meeting, invites council to join.

Attorney Report: Eric Jones states Tristany Hoffman was sentenced from 3-7 years in the Wyoming Women's Correction Center. Her original plea agreement required her to make restitution at the time of sentencing, which she did not do. We will now be seeking a claim with the bonding company. Explains process of paying back restitution.

New Business

Coble Building Permit: Motion to approve Mr. Coble's Building Permit #25-4 by Heather Schoning, seconded by Jeston Cundall. All in favor, motion is carried.

Vacating "D" Street: We had some residents who are asking if we will vacate "D" Street. Eric Jones discusses the process to vacate. His concern is utilities; it has been decided we will do more research on this.

Old Business

Community Center: Community Center is a design build; public works building is to be built to specifics. Discussion on ad dates and specifics for bids and meetings.

Old Hotel: Ms. Joelson filed notice of appeal to the Supreme Court, this places everything on hold for the time being.
